

REGIONAL WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT CENTER

Funded by the Commonwealth of Virginia, the Cities of Franklin and Suffolk, the Counties of Isle of Wight and Southampton, area businesses and private donors, the \$5.28 million-dollar facility houses the offices of Workforce Development and the Hampton Roads Workforce Investment Board's One-Stop Job Center.

FLOOR PLAN


The regional Workforce Development Center is a 32,000 square-foot facility with space available for a variety of training and conference needs. Flexible floor plans and room arrangements accommodate small meetings as well as large conventions. A substantial information technology infrastructure makes the Center an ideal site for your organization to benefit from state-of-the-art learning methods and multi-site communication capability.

CONFERENCE HALL

The Conference Hall is a 6,800 square-foot facility that can be divided into two separate areas. Seating more than 300 at roundtables or 625 in moveable theater-style seating, the full Conference Hall affords optimal flexibility for conventions, banquets, receptions, class reunions, and other special events. Designed for the ultimate in acoustic control, the Conference Hall features an optional speaker's platform. Three overhead projectors provide large screen computer and video images. A reinforced floor and large roll-up door provide access for large equipment for training purposes and trade shows.

TECHNOLOGY THEATER

The semicircular arrangement of this tiered theater permits optimal use of space. Each of the 124 fixed tabletops is wired for data, power and microphones. Equipment includes a full duplex audio conferencing system.

COMPUTER LABS

Each of the two spacious, carpeted, and tiered labs accommodate 20 participants with high-speed internet connections and compressed video capability. An additional open computer lab is available for small group and individual activities

TRAINING ROOMS

Four training rooms can be arranged to meet particular training needs. These rooms can also accommodate breakout sessions from the Conference Hall. Each room can seat 20-24 participants in a variety of floor plans. Two rooms share a moveable partition that allows for a larger training area that will accommodate 40-50 participants.

EXECUTIVE CONFERENCE ROOM

Providing organizations with an upscale business meeting setting at a "get-away" location, the room features comfortable seating, a board-style table, teleconference capability, and ceiling-mounted projector.

CATERER'S KITCHEN

A warming kitchen is available to provide service to the Conference Hall, Training Rooms, and Executive Conference Room. Reservations are required through the Workforce Development office.
