

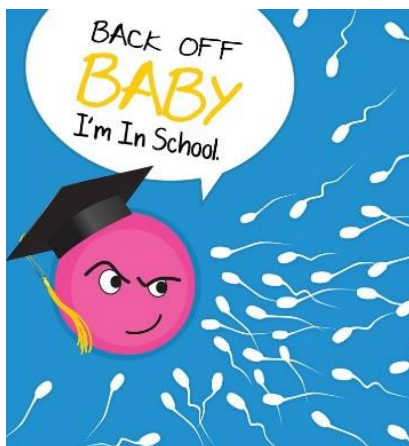
Did you know?

An unplanned pregnancy can make it harder to succeed in school—61% of women who have children after enrolling in community college fail to finish their degree, which is 65% higher than the rate for those who didn't have children.

Couples who remained together after the birth, both mothers and fathers reported significantly lower happiness in the relationship, if at least one member of the couple did not plan the pregnancy.

To raise a child to the age of 18 will cost between \$164,000 and \$407,820 (numbers differ depending on where you live, if you are a single, and income levels)

In a recent survey given by The National Campaign, 90% of unmarried young adults aged 18-29 believed (and 66% strongly believed) they have all the knowledge they need to avoid an unplanned pregnancy, but in reality, many people knew little to nothing about even the most commonly used methods of birth control.
